Howard S. Erlanger is Voss-Bascom Professor of Law, Emeritus, at the University of Wisconsin Law School in Madison. He continues to teach and consult in the areas of wills, trusts, marital property, and estate planning. Professor Erlanger is the recipient of several awards for his work in these areas, including the Charles Dunn Award from the State Bar of Wisconsin for a series of articles written with June Weisberger on marital property and the Steiger and Underkofler Awards from the University of Wisconsin for excellence in teaching. From 1993 to 2023 he was an Academic Fellow of the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel (ACTEC). Professor Erlanger was the reporter for the State Bar committee that drafted the 1999 Wisconsin Probate Code (1997 Wis. Act 188) and the Probate Code trailer bill (2005 Wis. Act 216). He is a co-author of *Marital Property Law & Practice in Wisconsin* (6th ed. 2025), published by the State Bar of Wisconsin.
