

While hauling a heavy trailer, the defendant's pickup truck struck the rear of a semi-truck cab driven by the plaintiff, who claims he can no longer perform his job due to lower back injuries. The defendant claims his view was blocked. Witnesses include the plaintiff, defendant, responding police officer, vocational experts, treating neurosurgeon, and IME neurosurgeon. The jury will deliberate on liability and damages. **9.5 CLE**

22nd Annual Institute of Trial Practice (2011)

Two friends end up in a one-vehicle accident on the way to a gentlemen's club. The plaintiff was ejected from the truck and sustained serious injuries. The level of inebriation resulted in varying accounts of the evening, including who was driving the defendant's vehicle. There will be testimony from the parties and their reconstruction experts. The jury will deliberate on liability. **9.5 CLE**

23rd Annual Institute of Trial Practice (2012)

This case involves a "slip and fall" in a hospital parking lot. A hospital employee – the plaintiff – injures her knee and alleges the defendant — a snow-removal company — was negligent in safely maintaining the premises. There will be testimony from the plaintiff, a snowplow company employee, and the hospital facilities manager. Expert testimony will include recorded testimony for trial of the treating physician, and testimony by the defense IME doctor. The jury will deliberate on liability and damages. **9.5 CLE**

Presiding Judge: Hon. William C. Griesbach, U.S. District Court Eastern District, Green Bay, and the Wisconsin chapter of ABOTA's 2012 Judge of the Year

26th Annual Institute of Trial Practice (2015)

On the way to the fire station, a volunteer firefighter slides through/runs a stop sign and collides with another vehicle, severely injuring a passenger. Hear testimony regarding the disputed condition of the pavement, as well as the speed and control of both vehicles. Also at issue are whether the firefighter had a "habit" of running stop signs and whether the other driver could see the firefighter's vehicle approaching. The case will be decided by a jury selected at the pre-trial half-day seminar, *How to Select a Jury*. **9.5 CLE**


